





Awards

Connemara Division Championships Awards presented after Sunday's classes

CONNEMARA DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIPS

All Divisions will be divided into Open and Child/AA if entries warrant.

Connemara Division Championships are for Connemaras and Halfbred Connemaras only.

Dressage Division: Champion and Reserve Champion to the Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the highest combined percentage scores in two dressage tests, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: 4-18)

Prospect Division: to both the Purebred Connemara and Halfbred Connemara with the most points in their division and 2 Introductory level dressage tests. (Qualifying classes: Qualifying classes: 1, 2, 36-38, 71) Any horse/pony entering walk/trot classes may not enter any class which canters.


Green Division: to both the Purebred Connemara and Halfbred Connemara with the most points in their division and 2 dressage tests, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: Qualifying classes: 4-18, 42-44, 72)

Regular Division: to both the Purebred Connemara and Halfbred Connemara with the most points in their division and 2 dressage tests, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: 4-18, 45-48, 73)

Junior Division Champion: to the junior rider on either a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara, age 17 & Under, with the most points in their division and two dressage tests, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: 4-18, 42-48, 61-66, 69)


AA Division Champion: to the adult rider on a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara, age 18 & Over, with the most points in their division and two dressage tests, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: 4-18, 42-48, 61-66, 70)

Riders 12 and Under Division: to the rider on a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the most points in their division and two Introductory level dressage tests. (Qualifying classes: 1, 2, 49-52, 68) Any rider entering walk/trot classes may not enter any class which canters.









Awards

Perpetual Trophies

Consummate Connemara Trophy: Donated by Helen & Mel King. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara, regardless of age or sex, who, in the opinion of the judges, exemplifies the breed in the following: TYPE – TEMPERAMENT – CONFORMATION – ATHLETIC ABILITY – MOVEMENT, in that order. To retire the trophy, it must be won three consecutive years by the same Connemara. (Enter any classes you wish, this is judge's decision.)

*Castle Monarch Trophy: 2023 by Kathy Lucas, Gately Farm. Awarded to the purebred Connemara stallion with the most points from two dressage tests, Introductory level or higher, and all breed and performance classes. (Qualifying classes: 1-78)

<u>Supreme Breed Champion Trophy:</u> 2022 by Darian and Allen Hall, Rosewood Connemaras. To be awarded to the winner of the in-hand Supreme Breed Championship.

Cecilia W. Noonan Memorial Trophy: Originally donated by the Ervin Family, Merry-Go-Round Manor. 2021 Award sponsored by Allen and Darian Hall, Rosewood Connemaras. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara mare with the most points from two dressage tests, introductory level or higher, and all in-hand, and all performance classes, (open or classes restricted to Connemaras). (Qualifying classes: 1-78 except 53-60)

Connemara Gelding Performance Trophy: 2021 Trophy donated by Richard Cunningham and Katie Doyle. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara gelding with the most points from two dressage tests, one hunter division, and the performance classes. No points awarded for games. (Qualifying classes: 1-78 except 53-60)

<u>Cricket's Dew Flutter-By Perpetual Trophy:</u> Donated by Sandy Stuart. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara with the most points from two dressage tests, Training level or higher, breed classes and the Regular Hunter Division. (Qualifying classes: 4-18, 25, 28, 29, 45-48, 73)

<u>Prospect Trophy:</u> Donated by the Ervin Family, Merry-Go-Round Manor. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the most points in the Prospect Division. (Qualifying classes: 36-38, 71)

<u>Junior Rider Trophy:</u> Donated by Michael and Charlene O'Neil, Ballyneil Farm. Awarded to the rider 17 and under riding a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the most points from two dressage tests, training level or higher, and all performance classes. (Qualifying classes: 4-18, 42-48, 61-78)

<u>Adult Amateur Trophy:</u> Donated by Aeron Hynes, Dauntsey Farm, awarded to the Adult Amateur Rider on a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the highest point average from all ridden classes. (Qualifying classes: 1-18, 36-48, 61-66, 70-73)

Orchard Hills Funny Princess: Donated by Aeron Hynes, Dauntsey Farm, in memory of Orchard Hills Funny Princess. Awarded to the Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara and rider combination with the highest point average from two dressage tests, two hunter classes. (Qualifying classes: 1-18, 20-29, 36-48)

<u>AnNinon Beag Dressage Trophy:</u> Trophy donated by Gately Farm. Awarded to the dressage rider 12 years and under on a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the highest test score from the Introductory level tests. (Qualifying classes: 1, 2)

Louise LeBeau Trophy: Awarded to the dressage rider 13-17 years on a Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara with the highest test score from any dressage test, Training level or higher. (Qualifying classes: 4-18)

Larry Ervin Memorial Trophy: Donated by Darian and Allen Hall, Rosewood Connemaras. Awarded to the highest placed Purebred Connemara or Halfbred Connemara in the highest division of the Irish Derby. To be eligible, horse/rider combination must ride Training Level 3 or above and Irish Derby/Pre-Training Jumpers (2'9). Dressage score will be converted to penalty points. As for a combined test, the winner will be determined by the lowest penalty score. (Qualifying Classes: 6, 63)

What is a Connemara?

The American Connemara Breed Standard

Connemaras in North America range from 13 to over 15 hands. Their colors are grey, bay, brown and dun, with some roans, an occasional black, chestnut or palomino. Piebalds and skewbalds are not acceptable for registration.

Connemaras are the product of their original environment, the rugged mountain coast of West Ireland. Surefooted, hardy and agile, they possess powers of great stamina, staying power and adaptability. They are renowned for their versatility and their gentle, tractable, sensible and willing dispositions.

The following Breed standards have been published for many years as the basis for the American Connemara Pony Society, (ACPS), description for a Connemara. Since the early 1990's, the ACPS has been a member of the International Committee of Connemara Pony Societies, (ICCPS). Attached to each section of the ACPS Breed Standards given below, and presented in parentheses and italics, are the breed Standards as written in the ICCPS Rules.

Temperament: Mannerly and manageable, kind, responsive, possessing good sense and basic intelligence.

Type: Rugged and sturdy; body compact and deep through the heart, with well-sprung rib cage and broad chest. (ICCPS:Compact, well-balanced riding type with good depth and substance and good heart room, standing on short legs, covering a lot of ground).

Action: Straight and true both front and rear with free movement in the shoulders. Connemaras should move underneath themselves and should be sure-footed, athletic and clever, covering a lot of ground. (ICCPS: Movement free, easy and true, without undue knee action, but active and covering the ground).

Head: Kind eye, head well-shaped and balanced in proportion to the rest of the body; neck of good length and definition, meeting the shoulder smoothly. (ICCPS: Well-balanced pony head of medium length with good width between large kindly eyes. Pony ears, well-defined cheekbones, jaw relatively deep, but not coarse).

Shoulders: Laid-back with good slope. (ICCPS: Head well-set onto neck. Chest should not beover-developed. Neck not set on too low. Good length of rein. Well-defined withers, good sloping shoulders).

Back: Strong and muscular; some length of back is normal in Connemaras, especially in mares. (ICCPS: Body should be deep with strong back, some length permissible, but should be well-ribbed up with strong loins).

Hindquarters: Well-rounded and deep with good length from the point of the hip through the haunch; should balance the shoulders. (ICCPS: Strong and muscular with some length, well-developed second thigh, (gaskin), and strong low-set hocks).

Bone: Clean, hard, flat, measuring 7-8 inches below the knee for Connemaras under 14.2, more for those over that height; forearms and gaskins long and muscular, cannons short and very dense. (ICCPS: Good length and strength in forearm, well-defined knees and short cannons, with flat bone measuring 18 cms to 21 cms).

Joints: Large and well-defined.

Feet: Hard, strong.

(ICCPS: Characteristics: Good temperament, hardiness, staying power, intelligence, soundness, surefootedness, jumping ability, suitable for child or adult).
